

Installation...

- 1. Remove the four phillips-head screws that secure the lens to the reflector.
- 2. Remove the lens from the reflector.
- 3. Using a gasket remover (or similar tool), remove the existing silicone gasket from the lens.

IMPORTANT: Do not allow the gasket removal tool to gouge, scratch or disfigure the lens in any way!

- 4. If you are installing a gasket on an early-style reflector, install the supplied double-sided tape in the reflector chanels as shown (the tape is not needed on current-style reflectors). Now position the new gasket into the reflector chanel.
- Return the lens to it's mounting location on the reflector. Be sure that the gasket is fully seated and is not being pinched or distorted by the lens.
- 6. Replace the lens mounting screws and re-tighten. Use hand-tools only;do not over-tighten.
