

WARNING: The strobe light power supply is a high voltage device. Do not remove the strobe tubes or dismantle the strobe lightheads in the system while the unit is in operation. Wait 10 minutes after turning off power to work on the system.



- . Remove the endcaps by first removing the 4 endcap screws and then pulling the endcap off. Install the alley lights onto the endcaps by aligning the reflector of the alley light with the 4 bosses in the endcap, then press the reflector in place until the 4 barbs in the endcap snap into place and engage the reflector.
- Plug the lightheads into the connectors labeled LA and RA and replace the endcaps. Installation is complete. Test the operation of the lightbar before returning it to service.



- 2. Plug the lightheads into the connectors labeled LA and RA and replace the endcaps. Installation is complete. Test the operation of the lightbar before returning it to service.
