# Safety First

This document provides all the necessary information to allow your Whelen product to be properly and safely installed. Before beginning the installation and/or operation of your new product, the installation technician and operator must read this manual completely. Important information is contained herein that could prevent serious injury or damage.


- Proper installation of this product requires the installer to have a good understanding of automotive electronics, systems and procedures.
- If mounting this product requires drilling holes, the installer MUST be sure that no vehicle components or other
  vital parts could be damaged by the drilling process. Check both sides of the mounting surface before drilling
  begins. Also de-burr any holes and remove any metal shards or remnants. Install grommets into all wire
  passage holes.
- If this manual states that this product may be mounted with suction cups, magnets, tape or Velcro™, clean the
  mounting surface with a 50/50 mix of isopropyl alcohol and water and dry thoroughly.
- Do not install this product or route any wires in the deployment area of your air bag. Equipment mounted or
  located in the air bag deployment area will damage or reduce the effectiveness of the air bag, or become a
  projectile that could cause serious personal injury or death. Refer to your vehicle owners manual for the air bag
  deployment area. The User/Installer assumes full responsibility to determine proper mounting location, based
  on providing ultimate safety to all passengers inside the vehicle.
- For this product to operate at optimum efficiency, a good electrical connection to chassis ground must be made. The recommended procedure requires the product ground wire to be connected directly to the NEGATIVE (-) battery post.
- If this product uses a remote device to activate or control this product, make sure that this control is located in an area that allows both the vehicle and the control to be operated safely in any driving condition.
- Do not attempt to activate or control this device in a hazardous driving situation.
- This product contains either strobe light(s), halogen light(s), high-intensity LEDs or a combination of these lights. Do not stare directly into these lights. Momentary blindness and/or eye damage could result.
- Use only soap and water to clean the outer lens. Use of other chemicals could result in premature lens cracking (crazing) and discoloration. Lenses in this condition have significantly reduced effectiveness and should be replaced immediately. Inspect and operate this product regularly to confirm its proper operation and mounting condition. Do not use a pressure washer to clean this product.
- It is recommended that these instructions be stored in a safe place and referred to when performing maintenance and/or reinstallation of this product.
- FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS COULD RESULT IN DAMAGE TO THE PRODUCT OR VEHICLE AND/OR SERIOUS INJURY TO YOU AND YOUR PASSENGERS!

## Installation:

- Remove the 4 phillips sheet metal screws that hold the top housing on and then carefully pull the top and bottom of the housing apart.
- 2. Remove the end cap from the light rack (Fig. 1).

WARNING: Do not tug on lighthead wires. Damage may occur.



holes in the light rack (C) and secure the bottom housing to the light rack with the #10 Torx Head screws (Fig. 2).

- Secure the top of the light housing using the 4 sheet metal screws that you removed in step 2. Be careful not to pinch the wires in the process (Fig. 2).
- 6. Extend the wires to your power source and installation is complete.

#### Wiring: Fig. 2 WARNING! All customer supplied wires that the connect to positive terminal of the battery must be sized to supply at least 125% of the maximum operating current and FUSED at the battery to carry that load. DO NOT USE CIRCUIT WITH **BREAKERS** THIS PRODUCT! Extend the BLACK wire to a ground and the RED wire to +12 VDC. Fuse the RED wire at 5 amps (A customer supplied switch is 10-24 X 1" **Torx Head** recommended). Connect the GREEN Screw (Qty 2) (SYNC) wire to the SYNC wire of other SYNC capable lighting options or with the opposite rack light.

# Operation:

When you apply power to the RED wire all lightheads will run in the SignaAlert™ 75 flash pattern.

**SYNC:** The GREEN wire is for SYNC. When you connect the GREEN wire to the SYNC wire of other SYNC capable lights, this unit will flash simultaneously or alternately with them.
